

Lake Hiawatha Swim Club, Inc.
2014 Rules and Regulations
General

The Board of Directors has the right to change, suspend, add to, or withdraw any or all of these rules and regulations without notice; and reserves the right to refuse, suspend, or cancel any membership which, in its opinion, is prejudicial to the best interests of the club and its members. Anyone violating those rules and regulations hereafter promulgated may be subject to the cancellation of membership without refunding of membership, locker, or guest fees and may be expelled from the facility.

Section 1: Membership

- 1:1. Memberships are sold only on a seasonal basis. No individual daily admissions are sold to non-members.
- 1:2. Each member older than 2 must present a membership card bearing the member's name and picture to be admitted to the Club.
- 1:3. Cards must be validated annually.
- 1:4. A fee will be charged for lost membership cards.
- 1:5. Membership cards cannot be sold, transferred, assigned, or used by non-members.
- 1:6. Refunds are not given for membership or locker fees.
- 1:7. Any person who has had Club privileges or membership suspended or revoked shall not be admitted as a guest.

Section 2: Operations

- 2:1. The Club reserves the right to modify Club hours or programs without advance notification. The Club has the right to modify the rules without notice
- 2:2. The Club reserves the right to make repairs, replacements, additions, or perform construction during the season.
- 2:3. Members must remove all property from lockers by the end of the last day of the season or it will be considered abandoned and may be disposed of by the Club.
- 2:4. The Club will not be held responsible for personal injuries, or the loss of or damage to personal property or automobiles of members or guests.
- 2:5. The Club reserves the right to regulate the Club parking areas. All persons must comply with posted parking and driving regulations.
- 2:6. Radios, "boom boxes," and other sound-producing devices are permitted if their operation does not disturb other Club members. The Pool Manager or Head Lifeguard may at any time request these be turned down or off.
- 2:7. The cost of any Club property damaged by a member, guest, or child of a member will be charged to the sponsoring member.
- 2:8. The Club Pool Manager, Assistant Manager, or Head Lifeguard may request any member, guest, or any other person to vacate Club property immediately if they believe it is necessary for the safety or comfort of the membership or in the Club's best interests.
- 2:9. Overnight parking is not permitted on Club property.
- 2:10. Members' guests must pay a daily guest fee.
- 2:11. Rain checks shall be issued for guest fees only at the discretion of the Pool Manager or Manager on Duty.

Section 3: Conduct on Club Property

The following are prohibited at all times.

- 3:1. Climbing of trees, fences, or buildings or hanging from any basketball nets, hoops, or backboards.
- 3:2. Use and possession of glass containers, alcoholic beverages.
- 3:3. Throwing refuse into the pool or leaving litter on any Club property.
- 3:4. Abusive language, physical violence, dangerous horseplay, screaming, yelling, or pretending to be in distress.

- 3:5. Operation of bicycles, skateboards, mopeds, or motorized toys. All bicycles, mopeds, and skateboards shall be walked in from the front entrance onto Club property.

The following are permitted only when approved by the Pool Manager or Head Lifeguard and then only in designated areas.

- 3:6. Cooking food on Club property.
- 3:7. Ball playing or other throwing games, including Frisbees.
- 3:8. Use of rafts or other types of flotation devices, including swim aids.

Section 4: Pool Use

- 4:1. All members and guests must observe rules and regulations established by the Pool Manager and lifeguards.
- 4:2. The Club reserves the right to close sections of the pool for safety or other considerations without prior notice.
- 4:3. The Head Lifeguard may evacuate the pool for any health or safety reason at any time.
- 4:4. In the event of lightning or thunder, all persons must evacuate the pool and pool aprons. New Jersey law dictates that the pool and apron may not be reopened until 20 minutes from the last sign of thunder or lightning.
- 4:5. Anyone refusing to evacuate the pool when ordered to do so by the lifeguards will be ejected from the club property.
- 4:6. Anyone with colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, infections, or bandages may be denied admission to the pool or kiddie pool.
- 4:7. No games, running, food, drink, smoking, or personal lawn furniture are allowed on the pool apron.
- 4:8. Eating, drinking, and smoking are not allowed in the pool. Smoking is allowed in designated smoking areas only.
- 4:9. No free swimming is allowed in or around the diving well.
- 4:10. All bathers must wear proper bathing attire in the pool. No cut-offs, underwear, or thong-type bathing suits are permitted.
- 4:11. Diving is prohibited except from the diving boards.
- 4:12. Pushing into, running into, or cannonballing into the pool from the sides of the pool is not allowed.

DIAPERS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE MAIN POOL AT ANY TIME, FOR ANY REASON. THIS INCLUDES SWIM TYPE OR DIAPERS SPECIFICALLY DESIGNATED FOR SWIMMING.

Section 5: Age Restrictions

- 5:1. Members must be 13 years of age to remain on Club property without an accompanying parent or legal guardian.
- 5:2. Guests under the age of 13 must remain in the company of and under the direct supervision of the sponsor member for the entire time of the guest's visit. Sponsor members are solely responsible for the conduct of their guests.
- 5:3. Children under the age of 7 must be accompanied by an adult when using the main pool.
- 5:4. Those 8 years of age or younger may use the kiddie pool.
- 5:5. No one under the age of 9 may dive from the high board.
